• **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

• **PHACS CAB EVALUATION SURVEY**

Megan talked about the January PHACS CAB Evaluation Survey. There were 8 responses. Topics suggested through the survey included:

- Oral Healthy Substudy;
- Engaging LGBT patients in care;
- Disclosure and new treatments;
- Education for adults;
- Study findings;
- Economic situations and prostitution in young people living with HIV;
- How antiretroviral medications affect teeth; and
- Support.

Additionally, the CAB expressed interest in having the storyline conference calls. **Megan** and **Claire** will work with the CAB to find a convenient date/time for the calls.

- **BRAINSTORMING QUESTIONS – CHILDREN’S MENTAL HEALTH**

Stephanie talked about children’s mental health. Many CAB members have expressed interest in learning more about children’s mental health. **Stephanie** suggested that the CAB come up with topics and questions. **Megan** will send the list of topics and questions to PHACS mental health professionals. **Megan** will invite a PHACS mental health professional to a future PHACS CAB conference call. Suggested questions/topics included:

- Violence;
- Behavioral issues and aggression;
- School factors;
- Depression;
- Mental health questionnaires in PHACS;
- Bullying;
- Self-harm;
- Disclosure and mental health;
- Factors that affect mental health such as socioeconomic factors, stigma, hormones, antiretroviral medications, HIV exposure, and social factors; and
- Parental influence.
