• HECC UPDATES

Mandy and Claire provided the HECC updates:

- 40th anniversary website
 - Mandy presented the updated website to the CAB. This website will host all HECC media.
 Mandy presented the new graphics and banners. She explained that they were updated to utilize warm colors. The tentative title of the website is "Project Positive". Claire encouraged CAB members to share their work for the website. Submissions could include videos, audios, and photos.
- New website banners

- SMART participant discontinuation letter

• CAB PAGES ON THE PHACS WEBSITE

Megan presented the new table of contents format for the study documents pages on the PHACS website. She explained that several studies are using the new format. This includes AMP Up, AMP Up lite, HOPE, and TERBO BRAIN. The new format is more user-friendly. **Megan** mentioned that the CAB pages on the website will be modified, as well.
