 - **Claire** led a focus group with parents of children and adolescents exposed to HIV but are not living with HIV. The group discussed strategies on:
 - How to communicate with parents about the developmental milestones of their children
 - How to communicate with parents if their kids are reaching their developmental milestones
 - During the conference, researchers will share the strategies provided by the focus group.
