SHIFTING LEADERSHIP, NEW CHAPTER FOR CAB

FEEDBACK ON LAY SUMMARIES

 - **Eduardo** suggested that the placement of the green and red circles should correlate with where marijuana is legal.
 - Flipping the image of the baby.
