#### • APPROVAL OF MINUTES

### • SCIENTIFIC AIMS BRAINSTORM

**Mandy** explained that the PHACS Fall Forum is scheduled for November 1, 2023, at 12PM ET. During the forum, every group in PHACS will have the opportunity to present their priorities.

At the last CAB meeting the topics below were discussed:

- Aging in HIV
- Whole Body Health
- Provider Retention
- COVID
- Men's Health

Mandy asked the CAB members if they had additional priorities:

- Samantha mentioned several topics of interest such as growing up being affected by HIV, women with children, long-term effects of HIV medication for women and their children, disclosure of HIV status to children and social support for people affected by HIV.
  - Mandy agreed disclosure of HIV status has been a very important topic. She mentioned a comic book created by the HECC that discusses the topic. Claire indicated that the "Caregiver's guide to disclosure" is a great resource to find ideas from other caregivers and guidance for different ages of kids.
- **Chitara** mentioned the lack of social support for kids that are HIV negative with positive mothers. In addition, people still have stigma around HIV. People affected by HIV should receive social support to deal with their self-esteem.
- **Mandy** suggested creating a document with definitions of tests for participants. The document would provide general definitions without making conclusions about anyone's health.
  - **Kim** agreed this resource will be helpful to give some guidance for participants. It will teach people to advocate for themselves.
