Title: Adolescent Master Protocol for Participants 18 Years of Age and Older (AMP Up)

PROTOCOL CO-CHAIRS:
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AMP Up

- Participants 18 and up
- Continuation of AMP
- Flexible online and clinic-based approach



Objective

To define the impact of HIV infection and antiretroviral therapy on young adults with perinatal HIV infection as they transition into adulthood.

Participation

- Perinatally HIV-infected participants
 - Target = 600
- Perinatally HIV-exposed but uninfected participants
 - Target = 250

Initial Enrollment

- Initial enrollment is limited to young adults currently or formerly enrolled in AMP.
- The protocol team will release a memo announcing when enrollment will be open to other individuals.



Study Visits

- Length of study for each participant is at least 6 years
- 7 study visits
 - Enrollment /Entry Visit (including informed consent), Year 3 and Year 6 – in clinic
 - Years 1, 2, 4 and 5 – optional at home or in clinic

Online Assessments

- Online assessments for AMP Up cover topics such as:
 - Demographics;
 - Health care utilization;
 - Quality of life;
 - Sexual behavior;
 - Reproductive history;
 - Substance use;
 - Adherence; and
 - Diet.

Specimen Collection

- Biological specimens to be collected during clinic visits:
 - Blood;
 - Saliva;
 - Throat wash;
 - Urine; and
 - Vaginal swabs.



Entry Visit (Year 0)

- Medical chart review;
- Clinic assessments;
- Real-time laboratory testing;
- Collection of specimens for testing and for repository;
- Hearing, language, and mental health assessments; and
- Online surveys.



Study Visits

Years 3 and 6

- Medical chart review;
- Clinic assessments;
- Real-time laboratory testing;
- Collection of specimens for testing and for repository;
- Hearing, language, and mental health assessments; and
- Online surveys.

Years 1, 2, 4, and 5

- Online surveys;
- Self-collection of specimens for STI testing; and
- Medical chart review.

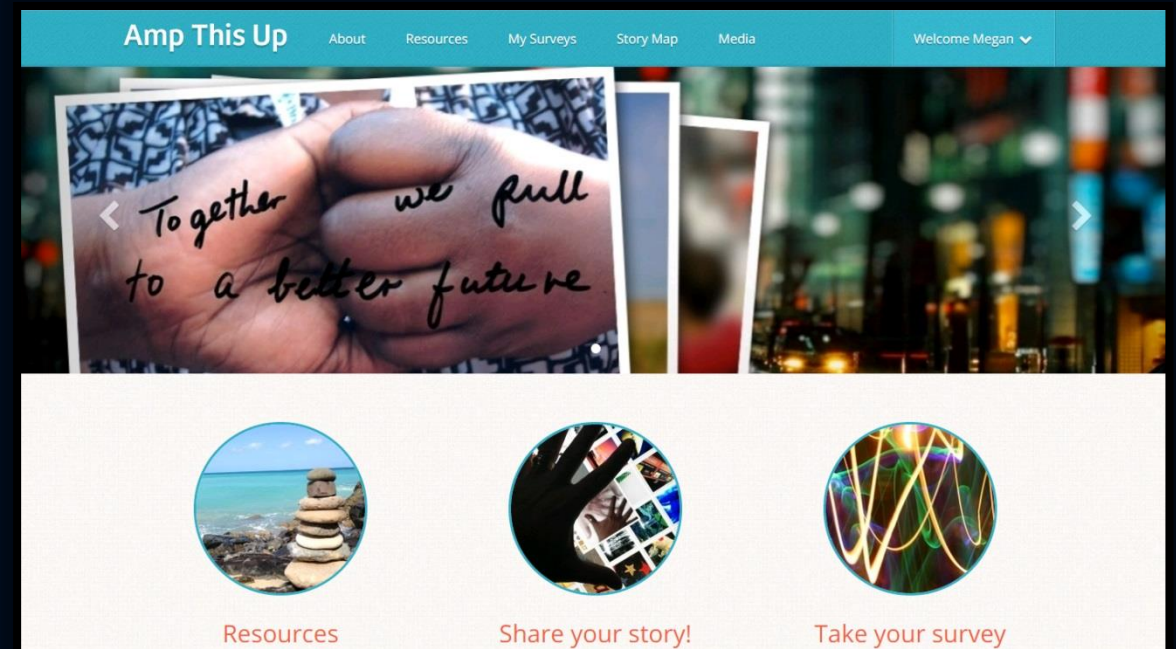
Study Visits
